## Recommendations

Once you've **sorted** your cards, count them **again** for 13 - in case one is unfanned behind another. (*I know people who seem to always lose a card that makes their bidding a bit iffy!*) Check you don't have any mixed suits.

(I count them by saying the shape, "5431" or whatever, and checking it adds to 13.)

Some people like to use a bidding box card as a flag to remind what the auction is. I believe this is strictly incorrect, but have never known anyone object to the practice. It shouldn't be necessary to do this.

Keep a count of trumps played. Preferably keep a note of which of the top 5 trumps remain unlocated.


Hold your cards up, so that opponents cannot see them. *It is apparently NOT illegal for an opponent to see your cards if you hold them badly.* It is illegal for your partner to see your cards (except dummy when on the table of course).

H:T9 makes 10H an honour.

H:T9\_7 is a "Broken sequence" which still counts.

*The honour headed sequence is generally a better lead than fourth highest.*

This one is more interesting, in that the achieved score when played in the "wrong" contract was better than the reference score.

However much of bridge bidding and play is using the percentages and sometimes the expected result doesn't work. It is still the case that using the recommended scheme will get the the best results overall.

*Also perhaps the play wasn't ideal. Maybe the defence could have kept Declarer down to a result less than that of the Reference.*

*Late news: In the set hand play today, the correct bid made an extra trick, thus beating the wrong bid. This doesn't prove anything, but is "kind'a reassuring"!*

### Play

**Play as if "Duplicate Pairs".**

{NS} have the pair number of their table, {N} has his back to the stage.  
{EW} have the pair number of their table plus 8.

Play boards in sequence. Have an incoming pile and an outgoing pile.  
Pass outgoing to next lower numbered table – Table 1 to highest table.

Some boards have instructions on card. **The appropriate people should read each card at the time it says and follow its instructions.**

**If you play a board twice, record the second play on the traveller using your pair numbers PLUS TEN (eg 1 v 9 becomes 11 v 19)**

*If you wish to fill in a personal results card, they are available here.  
They are commonly used at duplicate clubs.*

*Don't forget to describe partner's bids and plays to the table.*




